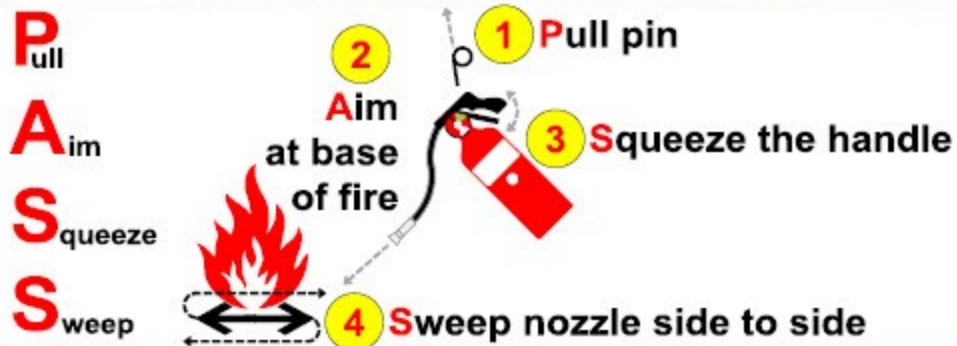


How to operate a fire extinguisher



Use the correct extinguisher & be properly trained

		<p>Ordinary Combustible Fire Type "A" Extinguisher Used for paper, wood, plastics, fabric, rubber, trash.</p>	
		<p>Flammable Liquids Fire Type "B" Extinguisher Used for gasoline, oil, grease, some paints and solvents</p>	
		<p>Electrical Fire Type "C" Extinguisher Used for energized electrical; appliances, computers, circuit breakers, wiring</p>	
		<p>Combination Extinguisher Type "ABC" Extinguisher Used on more than one type of fire, and is a good choice for home use.</p>	
		<p>Combustible Metals Type "D" Extinguisher Used on combustible metals like magnesium, sodium, etc.</p>
